- Guernsey is located just 60 miles of the south west coast of the UK and 30 miles from the west cost of France. Covers 24 square miles with a population of 65,000

FAQs



- **Do I need a passport to travel to Guernsey?**
Strictly speaking no, but airlines will insist on photographic identification at check in. It is therefore recommended that all travellers carry their passport with them when travelling to Guernsey.
- **Can I spend sterling in Guernsey?**
Guernsey has its own currency (the States of Guernsey pound) but Sterling notes and coins are accepted everywhere. A word of caution, Guernsey money can be exchanged at a bank in the UK but UK shops will not accept it. So spend your Guernsey money while you are here! The Guernsey £1 has the same value as £1 Sterling.
- **Should I take out travel insurance to cover my trip to Guernsey?**
All visitors are recommended to take out travel insurance for trips to Guernsey. Travelling rugby teams should consider group travel insurance to cover eventualities.
- **What happens if I fall ill or I am injured in a rugby match on a visit to Guernsey?**
There is no reciprocal health agreement in place with the UK. This means that any medical treatment required in the Channel Island's for UK residents is payable. For UK visiting teams we would suggest teams take out medical cover
